PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING OVERALL MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Half of the credits required for the major must be in upper-division courses.
- 2) A minimum of 15 credits must be taken in residence at WSU, 6 of which must be at the 400 level. The remaining credits can be taken either in residence at WSU or through WSU-approved education abroad, educational exchange courses, or equivalent transfer coursework.
- 3) 101-102 is the WSU language requirement and cannot count toward the major.
- 4) Language Conversation courses (105, 205, 305) do not count toward the major.
- 5) Only courses thus designated in the Catalog may be repeated for credit toward the major.
- 6) All courses taken for the major must be passed with a grade of C or better.
- 7) Courses counting towards a major in the language may not also be counted towards a major in International Area Studies (i.e. European Area Studies, Latin America Area Studies, German Area Studies, or French and Francophone Area Studies).
- 8) For course equivalencies taken in an approved Education/Study Abroad programs or as other transfer credits, please check with your language undergraduate advisor.

Earn 4 credits for 102 PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN101 TOTAL 8 credits

If you are placed in FREN 203 (Third Semester French) & get a B or better

Earn 4 credits for 203
PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN 102
PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN 101
TOTAL 12 credits

If you are placed in FREN 204 (Fourth Semester French) & get a B or better

Earn 4 credits for 204
PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN 203
PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN 102
TOTAL 12 credits

If you are placed in FREN 306, 307 OR 308 (Intermediate French) & get a B or better

Earn 3 credits for Fren 306, 307 or 308 PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN 204 PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN 203 TOTAL 11 credits
