<p>REQUIREMENT: PROFICIENCY EXAM-STAMP 4S</p> <p>Language majors and minors are required to take an exit proficiency exam at the end of the academic term in which they are enrolled in their last course for the major or minor. This exam is not graded, nor is the attainment of a certain level required, but is a requirement to determine each student's language proficiency level at the completion of their language studies at WSU. SPECIAL NOTES FOR THE FRENCH PROFESSIONS 2ND MAJOR:

- Students must take TWO Writing in the Major (M) courses: French 308 course and/or two writing in the major course from the student's first major.
- No course in which a C- or lower grade is earned will be counted toward the major; pass/fail courses do not count in the major.
- No course may be repeated for credit toward the major and the French Area Studies minor.
- Of the 33/34 credits required for the major, at least 15 must be taken in residence at WSU. These 15 credits may not be earned using advanced placement or challenge exam credit. Six (6) of these 15 credits in residence must be at the 400-level.
- Credits of 105/205/305/405 may not be applied towards the major or minor.
- A maximum of 12 credits per semester OR 18 credits per two semesters may be transferred from study abroad.
- ***THE FRENCH PROFESSIONS MAJOR IS A 2ND MAJOR ONLY, CANNOT BE USED AS A 2ND DEGREE.***

LANGUAGES ADVANCED PLACEMENT CREDIT

FOR EXAMPLE:

Take FREN 102 (Second Semester French) & get a B or better

Earn 4 credits for 102

PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN101

TOTAL 8 credits

Take FREN 203 (Third Semester French) & get a B or better

Earn 4 credits for 203

PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN102

PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN 101

TOTAL 12 credits

Take FREN 204 (Fourth Semester French) & get a B or better

Earn 4 credits for 204

PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN 203

PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN 102

TOTAL 12 credits

Take FREN 306, 307 OR 308 (Intermediate French) & get a B or better

Earn 3 credits for Fren 306, 307 or 308

PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN 204

PLUS 4 AP credits for FREN 203

TOTAL 11 credits
