SPECIAL NOTES FOR THE JAPANESE PROFESSIONS 2ND MAJOR:

- Students must take TWO Writing in the Major (M) courses: JAPN 320 or ASIA 330 or [M] courses from 1st Major Discipline.
- No course in which a C- or lower grade is earned will be counted toward the major; No course taken pass/fail may be included for credit toward the major.
- Of the 37 credits required for the major, at least 15 must be taken in residence at WSU. These 15 credits may not be earned using advanced placement or challenge exam credit. Credits of 105/205/305/405 may not be applied towards the major or minor.
- A maximum of 12 credits per semester OR 18 credits per two semesters may be transferred from study abroad.
- THE GERMAN PROFESSIONS is an additional major, and does not lead to a degree.
