#### **REQUIREMENT: PROFICIENCY EXAM-STAMP 4S**

Language majors and minors are required to take an exit proficiency exam at the end of the academic term in which they complete the last course of the major or minor. This exam is not graded, but is a requirement to determine each student's personal language proficiency level, and are used for SLCR assessment purposes. This exam requires a fee. #### SPECIAL NOTES FOR THE SPANISH LANGUAGE-LATIN AMERICAN-LATINX MAJOR:

- 1. The major requires these UCORE courses: CES 151 [HUM]; CES 254 [SSCI]; SPAN 311 or 351 [ARTS]; SPAN 321 [DIVR], SPAN 450, 451 and/or 452 [CAPS].
- 2. A grade of C or better must be earned in all required major coursework. 300-400-level courses taken pass, fail may not be included for credit toward the major.
- 3. Of the 61 credits required for the major, a minimum of 15 credits must be taken in residence with 6 of these credits at the 400 level.
- 4. A maximum of 12 credits per semester or 18 credits per year earned in a study abroad program may be applied toward the major.
- 5. Credits for Spanish 105, 205, 305, and 405 may not be applied toward the major.
- 6. All majors must complete an exit proficiency examination during the semester in which they complete the last language course of their major. There is a fee charged for the exam.
