

WSU Hearts in Motion 2026

Medical Mission to Guatemala March 12-22, 2026

HIM is a nonprofit organization committed to providing medical care to impoverished and undeserved regions of Guatemala. In partnership with WSU, HIM offers students the opportunity to participate in a medical mission that not only delivers vital healthcare services but also provides a culturally enriching experience, allowing students to make a meaningful impact in the lives of those in need.

Cost:

- The HIM fee is \$1350, which includes all trip-related expenses (housing, meals, and ground travel) while in Guatemala.
- Airfare on average costs from \$600 - \$900 round trip.
- A \$50 non-refundable acceptance deposit, which will be applied towards the \$200 administrative fee.
- All students must pay a \$31 trip insurance fee.
- Estimated total cost is approximately \$2500.
